

## *Dress Code of Precept Schools of Virginia*

School uniforms are required. Uniforms can be purchased through approved vendors such as [www.landsend.com](http://www.landsend.com), [www.schoolbelles.com](http://www.schoolbelles.com), [www.jcpenney.com](http://www.jcpenney.com), [www.kmart.com](http://www.kmart.com), and [www.sears.com](http://www.sears.com). Because school uniforms can be purchased through a variety of vendors, please make sure to order the style and colors approved by PSV. Former Bedford Christian Academy families are welcome to use **any** BCA school clothing. Otherwise, if you are ordering **new** school uniforms, please comply with the following Precept School of Virginia dress code.

Free used uniforms may be available, please contact the school to arrange a time to see what is available.

There are six basic pieces of clothing and a small number of accessories.

**Casual Top** For boys & girls Pre-K-9 solid burgundy/green/white long/short sleeve polo shirt

**Casual Bottom** For Pre-K-6 navy short, pant, skirt, OR skort (no cargo styles)  
For 7-9 Khaki short pant, skirt, OR skort (no cargo styles)

**Formal Top** For boys solid white oxford long/short sleeve shirt  
For girls Pre-K-6 solid white long/short sleeve Peter Pan collar blouse  
For girls 7-9 solid white long/sleeve oxford blouse

**Formal Bottom** For boys Pre-K-6 navy pant  
For boys 7-9 Khaki pant  
For girls Pre-K-6 blue-green plaid tunic jumper  
For girls 7-9 blue-green plaid knife pleat skirt

**P.E. T-shirt** For boys & girls any solid navy/white cotton t-shirt OR school t-shirt

**P.E. Bottom** For boys & girls any solid navy shorts or sweatpants

**Accessories** For boys blue-green plaid tie (to wear with formal top), dark belt, solid white/navy socks  
For girls dark belt (if wearing short/pant), solid white/navy socks/tights  
For girls 7-9 blue-green plaid cross tie (to wear with formal top)

**Shoes** Casual shoes for boys & girls low top sneakers (no pictures, flashing lights, hiking shoes, sandals or open-toed shoes)

Formal shoes for boys & girls solid black, brown, navy loafers or low-heel dress shoes (no sandals or open-toed shoes)

Students should wear their casual uniform, unless it is a P.E. or a formal chapel day (usually Wed.). Students in grades 7-9 will change for P.E., so they should wear their casual uniform to school and change into their P.E. uniform at school.

No hats or caps are worn in the building. Haircuts, makeup, nails and accessories should not cause **any** distractions. It is recommended that girls Pre-K-6 not wear makeup and that boys and girls not wear jewelry. If girls do wear makeup it should be clear or very light colored. Jewelry often gets lost, broken, and young children are often distracted during lessons by their jewelry. Please help the teachers reduce classroom distractions by **not** letting your child wear jewelry. Girls with pierced ears may wear posts. Please no tattoos, not even semi-permanent/removable ones.
